


Loosen the 2 bolts holding in the exhaust system at the catalytic converter. Save the bolts to be used again in new exhaust system.



Pull back the rubber isolators from the exhaust system.




Pull back the rear isolators from the mufflers.

Install the mid-pipe to the factory position, use the factory bolts. DO NOT TIGHTEN.




Install the Y-pipe using provided bolts and nuts. Secure the flanges using provided gasket. DO NOT TIGHTEN.



Make sure the hanger is in the isolator.




Take the passenger side rear muffler section hanger and insert it into the rear exhuast grommet.
