K&N<sup>®</sup> Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N<sup>®</sup> cabin air filter.

- 1. Locate glove box and open. Fig. 1
- 2. Locate the two glove box stop features and remove. Fig. 2 & 3
- 3. Once the glove box stop features are removed, locate the glove box shock. Remove fastener holding glove box shock. Depending on your vehicle, the fastener may be a screw or a clip. Allow shock and glove box to hang free to access the cabin filter housing. Fig. 4 & 5
- 4. Locate cabin filter housing; pressing the two tabs carefully lift up and remove the cabin filter housing cover. Fig. 6
- 5. Remove dirty cabin filter from housing. Once dirty cabin filter is removed clean any debris that might be present in the housing. Fig. 8
- 6. Install K&N® Cabin Filter into housing. NOTE: Filter will only fit one direction Fig. 8 & 9
- 7. Reverse steps 1-5 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the housing and apply the K&N<sup>®</sup> Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.


